Call to order by Chairman Mike White.

Board awarded bid for FY10 CDBG #14315, Water Project Rural Water District #2, Thackerville for Section 1 – Waterlines – W Brown Enterprises, Inc. \$79,155.00 Section 2 – Meters – Bids tabled. Section 3 – Telemetry – Kent Matthews dba ITS - Innovative Technology Solutions \$47,700.00. Section 4 – Generator & Add Alt 1 – All Bids rejected. Motion Wade, second Peery. Vote Yes – Wade, White, Peery. Millie Vance, Grant Administrator and Robert Mullins, Engineer with Mehlburger Brawley informed Board of Thackerville Water Board's decisions as to bids. Meters were tabled due to performance bond of Company and Generator bid was rejected due to finding a better cost on a generator from other companies.

Board approved Burn Ban rules and regulations as set by State of Oklahoma.

Presentation of updated rules & regulations by Emergency Management Director Tracey Smithwick. Changes included changing duration of a burn ban from 7 days up to 30 days. A burn ban may be withdrawn anytime by the Board of County Commissioners.

Burn Ban Resolution for all of Love County was tabled until March 21, 2011. Motion Wade, second Peery. Vote Yes – Wade, White, Peery. Present: Emergency Management Director Tracey Smithwick; Kenneth Gee, Noble Foundation; Robert Williams, Noble Foundation & Eastman VFD; Bub Williams, Eastman VFD; and Harold White, Eastman VFD. Smithwick explained Love County was in a moderate drought at this time. Noble Foundation was requesting an exemption to the fire ban with a prescribed burn order; explaining Noble was in the process of burning two different properties in Love County. Commissioner White asked Smithwick if Commissioners could decline a prescribed burn by law, Smithwick said Board of County Commissioners would have the say as to allow prescribed burns or not. Smithwick was asked if one company is granted a prescribed burn, would all other request for prescribed burns have to be honored; Smithwick replied each prescribed burn would be at the discretion of the Board. White and Williams had favorable remarks as to the Noble Foundation and their professionalism in the fires they had been doing.
