Update from the Love County Commissioners in regard to COVID-19 and operational procedure for the Love County Courthouse offices:

Effective March 27, 2020 the Supreme Court of the State of Oklahoma and the Oklahoma Court of Criminal Appeals; as per the Second Emergency Joint Order regarding the COVID-19 State of Disaster; closed all 77 counties courthouses to the public. The Love County Board of County Commissioners have ordered all county offices within the Love County Courthouse to be open from 8:00 AM to 1:00 PM for electronic communications only; i.e. telephone, fax, email. This order is to minimize cross-contamination and to aid in slowing the COVID-19 pandemic.

During this COVID-19 pandemic, we want to assure the Love County Citizens your county government officials are taking all necessary precautions to protect your safety, and that of our staff. We understand we are essential personal, and we are here to help our citizens. We are continuing to get information and tools to handle this pandemic by participating in briefings and communications with the White House, the State of Oklahoma, and the Emergency Management sector.

If you need to do business within Love County Courthouse, please follow the below steps.

- CANDIDATE FILING is April 8, 9 & 10, 2020, Wednesday Friday, 8:00 AM to 5:00 PM. All applicants need to go to the Courthouse westside basement door to the Election Board office. Please call the Election Board Office, 580-276-2242, for further assistances.
- Citizens can find information online at love.okcounties.org. This website will allow citizens to search county information. You can send a question by using the contact link of each office.
- You will need to mail all documents to the Love County office of choice. Include appropriate fees, the return address of the filed document and include a contact phone number for any questions we may have.
- All payments will be mailed out to vendors for payment; payments will not be available at this time for personal pickup.
